Humphrey of Greer, South Carolina, her Sister Susan Dyson of Hickory, North Carolina, as well as her three children and their spouses, William John Humphrey, Maria Garuti, James Palmer Humphrey, Jennifer Solomon Humphrey, Emily Suzanne Ligh, and Elmer Ligh.

A Graduate of Yorktown High School Arlington Virginia, class of 1962, she attended Catawba College in Salisbury, North Carolina and earned a Bachelors degree in Elementary Education in 1966. After teaching school and raising three children she returned to college in mid life, earning a M.A. in Liberal Studies from SUNY Stony Brook in 1991.

Anne married William in August of 1966. She was his devoted wife for 51 years, his traveling companion for business and pleasure, and his navigator both on and off of the road. 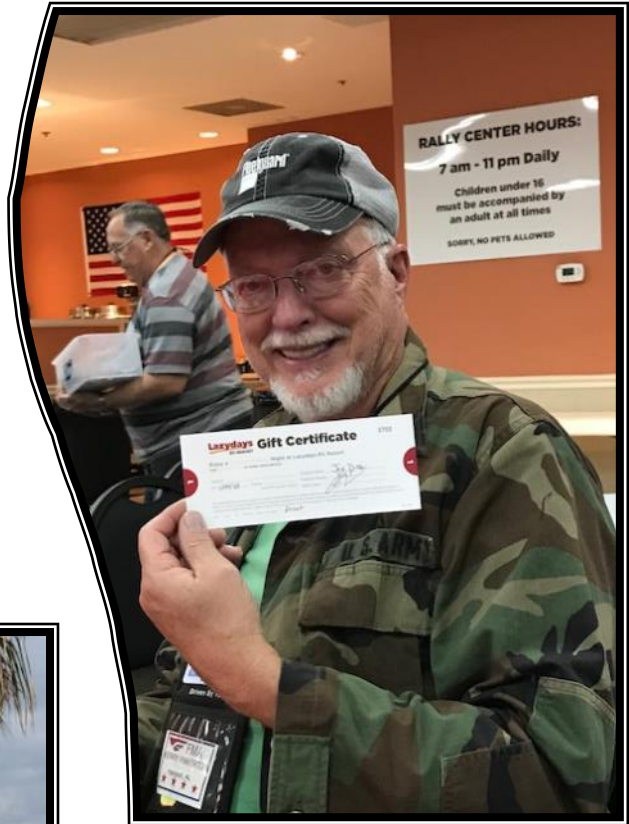
The meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.

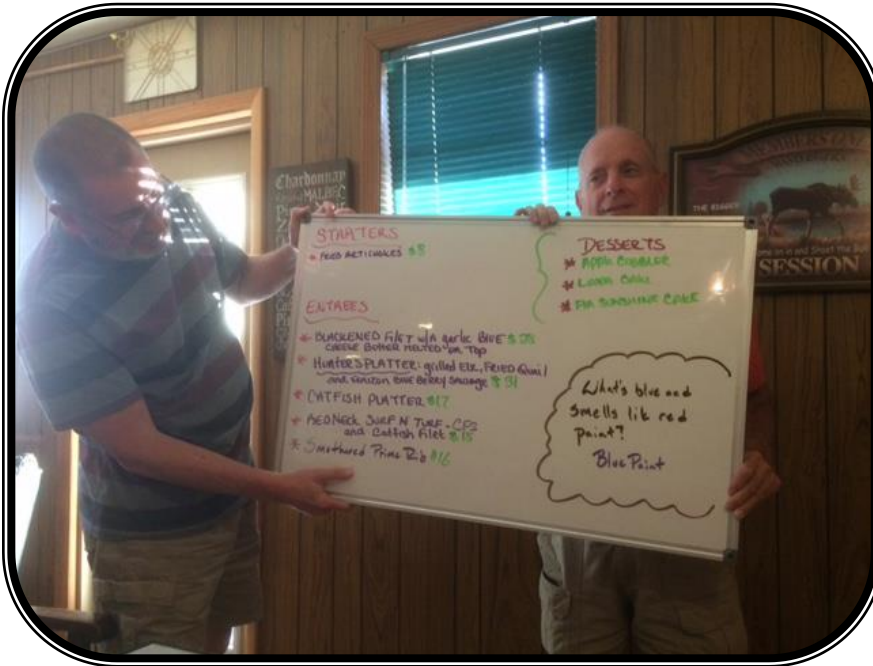

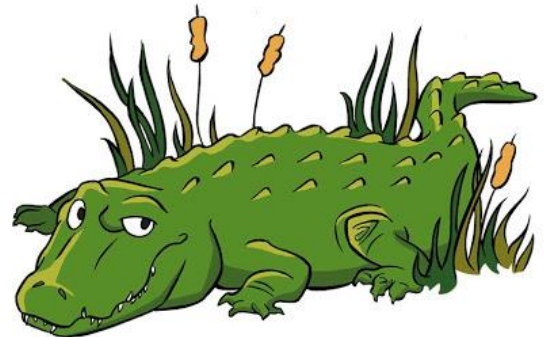

NUT CLUSTER

- 1 24 oz pkg. of chocolate almond bark
- 1 16 oz Planters dry roasted peanuts (in a jar)

Place almond bark in a large microwave bowl. Heat in microwave for 1 minute on high. Check to see if it is completely melted and can be stirred. Continue to Microwave 1 minute at a time for about 4 minutes until it is all melted and can be stirred. Microwaving only one minute at a time will ensure **YOU DO NOT BURN** the chocolate!

Remove from the microwave and stir in the peanuts. Drop by tablespoon (about a silver dollar size) on a long sheet of wax paper. The clusters will set up in about 20 minutes. No need to refrigerate. Really easy. Makes 25-30 pieces

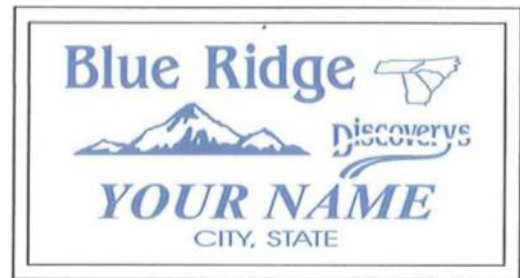

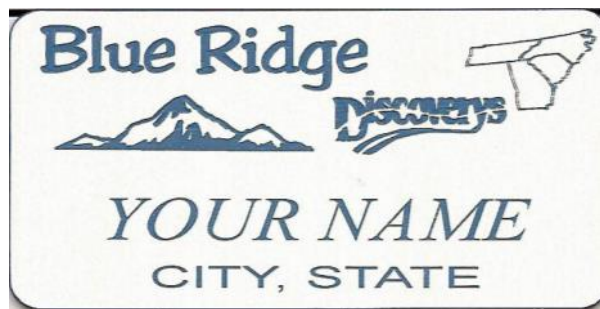
