NUT CLUSTER (Courtesy of Carolyn Pinkerton)

24 oz pkg. of chocolate almond bark
16 oz Planters dry roasted peanuts (in a jar)



Place almond bark in a large microwave bowl. Heat in microwave for 1 minute on high. Check to see if it is completely melted and can be stirred. Continue to Micro-

wave 1 minute at a time for about 4 minutes until it is all melted and can be stirred. Microwaving only one minute at a time will ensure **YOU DO NOT BURN** the chocolate!

Remove from the microwave and stir in the peanuts. Drop by tablespoon (about a silver dollar size) on a long sheet of wax paper. The clusters will set up in about 20 minutes. No need to refrigerate. Really easy. Makes 25 -30 pieces
