Make it yourself

Many of you probably experience the same roof drain problem that I do. The little drip rail extenders I got from Camping World just aren't long enough to direct the water away from the coach surface or the drivers mirror. I know some have used clothes pins but you have to use a ladder to install them and at our age we sometimes forget to remove them and they fall off as we go down the road. I took some plastic art paint spatulas (photo attached) that I got at Hobby Lobby and modified it a little by grinding a little off the handle so the water flows down to the end. I painted them to match trim color using plastics paint Then I drilled a hole in it and the drop rail extensions, used a stainless steel screw and self locking nut to permanently mount them (picture attached). Even if a tree branch contacts them you can just use your awning wand or cleaning brush handle to move it back in place once you are parked.

The good news is_I'll NEVER have another mammogram!! The 'other' news is, I'll be saying "Good-bye" to 'The Girls' on Wednesday.

I AM BLESSED, however! My diagnosis is 'Stage Zero', which means what is found remains contained in the duct. My treatment options were: 1. Lumpectomy, followed by radiation (NO, thank you!), or 2. Complete mastectomy, with or without reconstruction (3 options for re-con). My decision: I'll have the Big "M", and with my family history, "Make it a double"! Yes, I also had genetic testing.

This process has taken WEEKS!! (7) As is obvious, I have chosen to keep this very private during the process of diagnosis, treatment decisions, scheduling, and waiting. I hope you understand.

As I said earlier, I am Very blessed. Yes, cancer invaded my body, but we caught it as it stepped in. I am able to decide everything about my treatment and have a decent option, considering. While yes, I guess now I'll be considered a "Cancer Survivor", I really feel I have a completely different (much lesser) disease than most others. I only go through one surgery, plus the post-op stuff. NO chemo OR radiation to rack my body!

I have chosen the treatment options that will have the shortest recovery time, with the least invasion of the rest of my body. Yes, "The Girls" will come back (ha!) in another form of puberty, I guess! :-)

As confident as I am, I figure there will surely be some difficult days ahead. I'd love having your prayers embracing us. Yes, our adult children will 'tag-team' being with us. While there are many I love and care about, with whom my contact is primarily Facebook, I choose not to post this there. However, I no longer consider it a "private matter". It is just impossible to get to everyone at the same time. I hope you'll help me out here.

I'll see many of you soon, at Wesley UMC, on the pickle ball courts, streets of Augusta, and RV stops in the region in the weeks/months ahead! YES, we'll get to go to Tally for Christmas (thanks to our children), and make our winter trip to South Florida in January.

We count our blessings and are so thankful for all of you who help make our lives complete.

FOR THE COOK



Frank's Potato Salad (6-8 Servings)

4 ea Medium potatoes cubed (I normally use Yukon Gold or red skinned potatoes)

4 ea Hard boiled eggs

1 ea Medium onion diced (I use sweet Vidalia onions when available)

2 ea 16oz Chicken Broth (Use what you need to cover the potatoes)

4 tbs Pickle Relish (or add more for your taste)

Salt & Pepper to your taste

Hellmann's Mayonnaise (I use enough to give a good coating on the potatoes)

Paprika as needed for garnish

Boil the potatoes in the chicken broth until they are cooked a little al dente, but not at the mushy stage

Drain potatoes and let them cool

Dice three of the eggs and slice the 4th to lay on top of the salad as garnish

Once potatoes have drained and cooled, mix eggs, pickles, onions & mayo

Add sliced egg to top of salad and garnish with Paprika
