BY LAWS OF BLUE RIDGE DISCOVERYS A CHAPTER OF THE DISCOVERY OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this chapter shall be the **BLUE RIDGE DISCOVERYS** chapter of the Discovery Owners Association, Inc. The Chapter is formed as part of the Discovery Owners Association, Inc., a non-profit, volunteer organization.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The purpose of the chapter is to plan campouts, enhance camaraderie and to promote social contact among Discovery Owners. The Chapter primarily services DOAI members residing in Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee, but membership is open to all DOAI members.

ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP AND FEES

Section 1. Any person or family who owns a Discovery Motorhome and is a qualified member of the Discovery Owners Association Inc is eligible for membership in the **BLUE RIDGE DISCOVERYS** Chapter. Both Pilot and Co-pilot shall have membership and voting privileges.

Section 2. The annual dues for the **BLUE RIDGE DISCOVERYS** Chapter shall be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) a year. A member joining after January, will pay a pro rated amount equal to one dollar and twenty five cents (\$1.25) per month for the remainder of the year. Dues are due to the Treasurer by the 15th day of January each year. These dues were recommended by the chapter officers and accepted by the founding chapter members. Ten percent (10%) of these dues shall be remitted annually to the Treasury of the Discovery Owners Association, Inc. This amount will remain in effect, until changed by the membership.

ARTICLE IV - AUTHORITY

Section 1. The Chapter Officers shall be the administrative body of the Chapter and shall also perform such functions and duties as ordered by the Chapter.

Section 2. Any vacancy (ies) shall be filled by the officers for the unexpired term.

Section 3. The Chapter Officers shall hold meetings as they deem necessary, and the President or any two officers may at any time call a meeting.

Section 4. A majority of the officers shall constitute a quorum to hold a meeting on any specific item. Absent officers may mail their vote, if appropriate, to the Chapter Secretary prior to the meeting date.

ARTICLE V - OFFICERS

The officers of the Chapter are the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer Assistant Treasurer and Rally Master. The officers shall constitute the Board and shall perform the duties that usually pertain to these respective offices. Only one (1) family member can hold office and serve on the board, at the same time. They shall be elected by the Chapter members at the annual meeting, and shall hold office for two (2) years or until a successor has been duly elected and installed.

Section 1. The Assistant Treasurer will be a Non-voting position on the board. This position will be kept abreast of all financial activities by the Treasurer and be prepared to assume the duties of the Treasurer.

ARTICLE VI – COMMITTEES

Section 1. The nominating committee shall consist of three members appointed by the President in September. The chairman of the nominating committee shall present the proposed slate of officers at the next meeting. Nominations will also be accepted from the floor. Election of officers will take place at the November/December annual meeting.

Officers will assume their duties as of the following January 1.

BY LAWS CONTINUED

Section 2. Other committees may be appointed by the President and shall act for the duration of their assigned task.

ARTICLE VII - FINANCES

- Section 1. The fiscal year shall be the calendar year.
- Section 2. All funds of the chapter shall be deposited at Wachovia Bank, NA to the account of the **BLUE RIDGE DISCOV-ERYS**.

ARTICLE VIII - BY LAWS

Section 1. Amendment of bylaws.

- a. Changes to the bylaws may be proposed, in writing, to the Chapter Secretary, by any member. With the approval of the Board, such proposed changes will be mailed or e-mailed to all chapter members.
- b. Proposed changes to the bylaws will be mailed to each member thirty days prior to the meeting for which announcement has been made that a bylaws amendment will be presented. The bylaws may then be amended with a 2/3 majority vote on the Chapter members present AND VOTING.
- Section 2. Standing Rules may be written to address other Chapter procedures. In case of a conflict, the Chapter bylaws take precedence over the Chapter Standing Rules.
- Section 3. This chapter will operate under the bylaws and standing rules of the Discovery Owner Association, Inc., which shall take precedence over this document.

ARTICLE IX - TERMINATION OF CHAPTER

If the activities of the chapter terminate, any property or Chapter funds shall be donated to DOAI, a non-profit organization.

NOTE: This document has been approved as written by a majority of Blue Ridge Discoverys Member at the annual business meeting on October 22. 2010.

TECH TIP

Here's how my rear camera/monitor (Weldex) problems began. First I would loose picture while driving down the road. Sometimes it would come back on for no reason and sometimes it would come back on if I turned it off and back on. After trouble shooting the monitor as best I could, I felt it must be the camera so I took it out and cleaned up the connections, no help. Finally, I lost the picture permanently and could not get anything. I contacted RV Cams, Inc. in Baton Rouge, LA. They were very good. Talked to Brent who walked me through some trouble shooting and he also explained they had most of the parts and would check the monitor and/or camera AT NO COST (except for shipping). I removed the monitor and camera and sent it off to them. They checked both monitor and camera out the day after it arrived and called me to discuss the problem. My monitor was OK, and the camera was bad. They had one in stock, so I bought it and they shipped the new camera with my good monitor the same day. I received them two days later and reinstalled them in the coach. It works like a charm. The cost for the new camera was \$176 which is much cheaper than others who told me I would have to buy a color system because parts for the older (2005) black and white were no longer available. The other person I talked to at RV Cams was Chuck, both he and Brent were very knowledgeable and helpful. The best way to contact them is through e-mail, check on line at rvcams.com or phone (877)378-2267. I highly recommend this company based on my recent experience. Their web page is good and will give you a cross section of the products they service and sell. (Hank Haden)

2012 Spring Rally, Myrtle Beach, SC

The location for the 2012 Spring Rally will be at the Lakewood Camping Resort, Myrtle Beach, SC. Early arrival will be April 15-17; rally will be from April 18-22.
