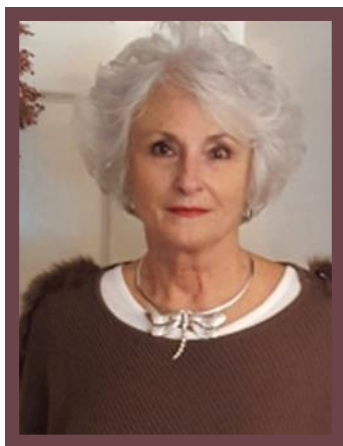
# DEDICATION

You woke this morning to the loneliness of bereavement... the empty bed or chair, an unaccustomed quietness, a life now incomplete –

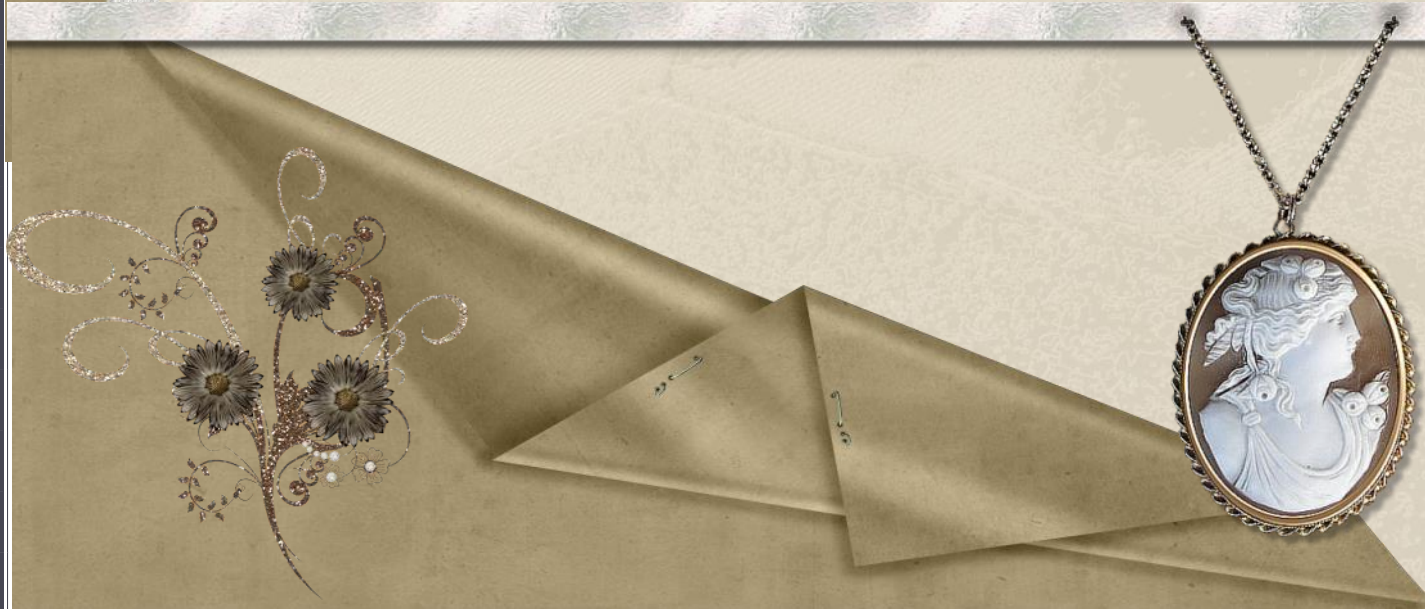

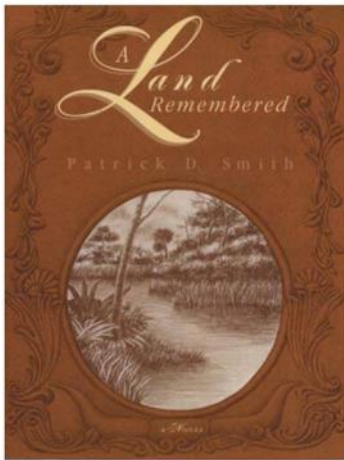

Grant came through his hip surgery with flying colors! It has been almost 4 weeks and he is now cane free and walking like his old self! I know he is excited to go camping now that he feels better.

Fred Needel is having back Surgery (by the time you put out the newsletter, it will be "had") on Dec 6 - a laminectomy and spinal fusion of 4 discs in his lower back. We will be wintering at home in suburban Baltimore and hopefully he will be ready for us to join the chapter in spring, in our new LXE 40D, which should be ready for us about the same time Fred is able to move better.

**Update:** - Fred's surgery was scheduled for last Thursday, as you know. We were 5 minutes from the hospital when the doctor's scheduler called us to cancel, the doctor called in sick! It was very frustrating since we were all psyched and ready but we were glad he didn't want to do anything that could potentially endanger Fred. It also gave us the chance to do a few activities over the weekend that we had been disappointed about missing due to the operation, so it was a good decision all around. Surgery is now scheduled for Monday morning unless we hear otherwise. I will send you an update after surgery when we talk to the doctor.

Fred had his spinal stenosis surgery today, 10 December, and everything went well, according to the surgeon. He had a laminectomy and spinal fusion in his lower spinal region. The surgeon said that the stenosis was bad, but what he expected from the MRI.

Fred will be in the hospital for a few days, then will be home for 6 weeks before his post-op visit. The doctor said it will take about 6 months for Fred to start to feel like himself again.

## Beef & Cabbage Soup (6 two cup servings)

### Ingredients:

1 yellow onion  
2 cloves garlic  
2 Tbs. olive oil  
5 cups shredded cabbage (about 1 lb.)  
2 (15 oz.) cans stewed tomatoes  
1/2 tsp. dried oregano  
1/2 tsp. dried basil  
freshly cracked pepper  
1 lb. ground beef  
6 cups beef broth (low sodium, if possible)  
1 Tbs. Worcestershire sauce  
1 lemon  
handful fresh parsley



### Preparation:

Dice the onion and mince the garlic. Add both to a large soup pot and saute' over MEDIUM heat, for about 5 minutes, until onions are tender. Add the ground beef and saute' until browned. If using higher fat content beef, drain off the fat once the beef is browned.

Add the shredded cabbage, stewed tomatoes (with juices), oregano, basil, some fresh cracked pepper, beef broth and Worcestershire sauce. Stir everything to combine.

Place a lid on top and turn heat to HIGH, and let it come to a boil. Once it starts to boil, turn heat down to LOW and allow to SIMMER for 30 minutes, until cabbage is very soft.

4. Taste the soup and add salt, if needed. Use a spoon to break up any large pieces of tomato into smaller pieces. Squeeze about 1 Tbs. of lemon juice into soup and add the fresh parsley. Stir to combine. Taste once more and make any further needed adjustments before serving.

### Notes:

Prep time: 10 minutes. Cook time: 50 minutes.

Serve with warm, crusty rolls or bread, cheesy, garlic or herb flavored.
