

Midwest Discoverers 2021 Fall Rally Welcome Letter

Phil Skiff and John Hooper are excited to be Co-Hosting the Midwest Discoverers Fall Rally for 2021 in the Metro Detroit area. When most people think of Detroit, they think of two things: cars and cold! But truly, there are a lot of wonderful things to see and do in the area. We want to show you just a few of them. If you have never been to the Henry Ford Museum in or toured a vehicle assembly plant, you will be amazed at what you've been missing. Of course, there are other venues just as amazing that you can see in the generous amount of free time built in to the itinerary.

Our rally will begin with arrival on Sunday, September 12th and end with departure on Saturday September 18th or Sunday, September 19th. Our reservations are for a full week, six nights, but rally activities end on Saturday morning. You can leave on Saturday or stay over one more night and leave Sunday, if you prefer. Some going directly to the national rally in Sevierville, TN, may want to leave Sunday and travel as a group. It's 590 miles to Sevierville – see the registration form for more information on this.

Of course, you can come earlier and stay later if you desire, though the park is pretty full and you may not be able to get one of the sites we have reserved for the rally. The weekly rate at Camp Dearborn is \$210, which is extremely reasonable. Your credit card will be charged that amount when you make your reservation. If you haven't already, you need to make your reservation before the end of July. There are limited number of sites reserved for us so please contact the reservations office at Camp Dearborn (248-684-6000) and tell them you are registering as a member of the Midwest Discoverers Rally.

The Itinerary for the Camp Dearborn Rally is attached and can also be found on the DOAI web site, www.discoveryowners.com. You do not have to log in to the web site. Click on Chapters, then select Midwest Discoverers and then Rally information. You can see the latest version of the Camp Dearborn Itinerary there. There will be changes to the Itinerary between now and the time of the rally, but most changes should be minor.

There are several open times during the week for you to choose what you want to do. Attached is a Detroit Activity Guide with nearly forty pages of unique things to see and do. We encourage you to do some exploring. We'll be about a 45-minute trip to most places in the metro area from Camp Dearborn. The town of Milford itself has a beautiful downtown area with shops and restaurants.

The Registration Sheet for the rally is attached. Please fill that out and return it with your check as soon as you can - August 15th at the latest.
